SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

This scholarship provides assistance to a North Carolina High School Senior who has met the eligibility requirements. The recipient must demonstrate a high level of participation and interest in Scottish art or Scottish culture.

ELIGIBILITY: The SCOT Senior Scholarship may be applied for by a current-year high school senior or high school graduate preparing to enroll in the first year of education beyond high school. An applicant must be a North Carolina resident who is involved in some aspect of Scottish culture.

FINANCIAL: The recipient of the SCOT Senior Scholarship will receive \$1,000. Funds will be paid directly to the recipient for the purpose of further education.

CRITERIA: Each applicant must submit a completed application to the Scottish Cultural Organization of the Triangle in one envelope no later than May 31 of the current year. Incomplete applications or those postmarked after May 31 of the current year will not be considered.

A completed application includes:

- The SCOT Senior Scholarship application form completed and signed
- A separate page listing awards/honors and interests/extracurricular activities
- An essay not to exceed 500 words on the topic provided on the application form.
- Three required letters of recommendation:
 - One from a person familiar with the applicant's Scottish connections who is not a member of the applicant's immediate family
 - One from a school teacher
 - One from a personal reference who is not a member of the applicant's immediate family
- High school transcript
